Human EGF R, Fc Tag(EGR-H5252) is expressed from human 293 cells (HEK293). It contains AA Leu 25 - Ser 645 (Accession # P00533-1). Predicted N-terminus: Leu 25

#### **Molecular Characterization**

EGF R(Leu 25 - Ser 645) Fc(Pro 100 - Lys 330) P00533-1 P01857

This protein carries a human IgG1 Fc tag at the C-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 94.7 kDa. The protein migrates as 110-140 kDa when calibrated against <u>Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker</u> under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.

#### **Endotoxin**

Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.

#### **Purity**

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

>90% as determined by SEC-MALS.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from 0.22  $\mu m$  filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4 with trehalose as protectant.

#### Storage


For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.


# SDS-PAGE

## Background

The epidermal growth factor receptor (EGFR; ErbB-1; HER1 in humans) is the cell-surface receptor for members of the epidermal growth factor family (EGF-family) of extracellular protein ligands. The epidermal growth factor receptor is a member of the ErbB family of receptors, a subfamily of four closely related receptor tyrosine kinases: EGFR (ErbB-1), HER2/c-neu (ErbB-2), Her 3 (ErbB-3) and Her 4 (ErbB-4). Mutations affecting EGFR expression or activity could result in cancer.
